



SRI LANKA LAW COLLEGE GENERAL ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

ADMISSION OF STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2027

Applications are called from eligible candidates through the online system for the competitive examination to be held in August 2026 for the admission of students to the full-time course for the academic year 2027 at the Sri Lanka Law College.

The application form is published on the website of the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka www.doenets.lk under the section “Our Services” under “Online Applications - Recruitment/EB Exams” and applications can only be submitted online. The online application process will commence on 30th March 2026 at 9.00 a.m. and will close on 30th April 2026 at 9.00 p.m. The applicant shall bear any adverse consequences arising from delaying the submission of the application until the closing date.

The **online** Examination Application shall be filled in the English Language only. Before filling the online application, download the instructions prepared for making application for the examination from the www.doenets.lk website of the Sri Lanka Examinations Department. In filling the application strictly follow the said instructions. Any amendment made to the application form after obtaining a printed copy will not be considered a valid amendment. Incomplete applications will be rejected without notice.

Eligibility for Entrance Examination

01. Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
02. Should have completed 17 Years of Age at the time of forwarding the Application. (Accordingly, only whose Date of Birth falls on or before 30-04-2009 could apply).
03. Should have obtained Two Credit Passes and an Ordinary Pass at once
 - (A) In the Sri Lanka General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) Examination conducted by the Sri Lanka Examinations Department Or
 - (B) In the General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) Examination of United Kingdom.
04. Possess a Credit pass in the English Language and a Credit pass in the Sinhala or Tamil Language, obtained at the Sri Lanka General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination or National Certificate of General Education Examination or an examination recognized by the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka as equal to the above examinations.

05. If there is any results which can be considered instead of the results mentioned in 03, 04 above, such qualifications would be published by the Incorporated Council of Legal Education and only those applicants who expect to apply accordingly, shall inquire on 070-6759892 prior to submitting application and obtain the permission of the Sri Lanka Law College.
06. If candidates with special needs are appearing for this examination, it is mandatory to mention it in the application form and copies of the relevant medical certificates must be submitted to the Sri Lanka Examinations Department along with a printed copy of the application form.

Entrance Examination

All applicants must appear for the entrance examination to be held in Colombo, August 2026. The Question Papers included for the Law College Entrance Examination are,

The applicants may provide answers to Question Papers in General Knowledge and General Intelligence in any one of the three media of Sinhala, Tamil or English.

Applicants who receive less than 40% marks in one or more of the above Question Paper/s would not be eligible for entrance.

In the selection of candidates for entrance on merit, only the marks obtained in Question Papers in General Knowledge and General Intelligence would be taken in to consideration.

The Medium of Language in the application submitted cannot be altered for any reason.

Examination Fee

(A) Examination Fee is Rs.1200/=. In paying the Examination Fee, the payments shall be made only under the following Fee Payment Scheme given in the Online System.

1. By any Bank Credit Card.
2. By any Bank Debit Card with the facility of Internet Transactions.
3. Online Banking Method / Flex App of Bank of Ceylon.
4. Through any branch of Bank of Ceylon.

- Instructions for the payment by above method have been published under the Technological Instructions of the Examination Department website relevant to the examination.
- Receipt of payment would be informed by a SMS or an email. Full amount of the Examination Fee shall be paid and the applications with payment of less or more of Examination Fee would be rejected. Sri Lanka Examination Department would not bear responsibility for the short comings occurring when paying Examination Fee on the above said Payment Method.
- **The Law College Fee** of the amount of Rs.12, 000/= shall be paid on / or before the 30th of April, 2026 **in the name of the applicant** to 063020073300 (Hulftsdorp Branch) of the Hatton National Bank in the name of Incorporated Council of Legal Education. **Only after forwarding the relevant receipt** to the **email address** at entrance@slc.ac.lk , shall forward the application to the Examinations Department online. In the relevant receipt applicant's Name with initials, National Identity Card Number and the Telephone Number shall be indicated in clear compulsorily. (Applications would be rejected on the reasons of Nonpayment of the above fee properly / Payment in another person's name / mentioning information other than of the applicant. Further, it would be useful for the applicants keeping their receipts with them.)

Examination Admission Card

- (1) After the last date for submission of applications, a soft copy of all the details of Applicants submitted online will be furnished to the Sri Lanka Law College by the Examinations Department. The Examination Admission Card will be issued only to the applicants who are approved by the Sri Lanka Law College. The Sri Lanka Law College is vested with authority to select the applicants who may sit the examination.
- (2) The Examination Admission Card will be issued only online. Immediately upon issuing the relevant Examination Admission Cards, a web announcement will be published by the Sri Lanka Examinations Department to this effect. If there is any applicant who had not received the Admission Card such applicant shall inquire regarding the same from the Institutional Examination Organization Branch of the Sri Lanka Examinations Department. In such an inquiry, it will be more effective for the applicant to send a request letter to the email address mentioned in the web notification, stating the name of the examination applied for, the applicant's full name, National Identity Card number and address. In such an inquiry, it will be useful to keep a photocopy of the completed application form and a photocopy of the receipt of payment of the examination fee in order to confirm any information requested by the Examinations Department. If the admission card is checked and any amendments are required, the relevant amendments should be made to correspond to the information provided in the application in time by contacting the Examinations Department. Requests for amendments made at the examination hall will not be considered.
- (3) Examination candidates must appear for the examination at the examination center assigned to them.

(4) For the confirmation of identity of the Applicants, any of the following documents will be accepted.

01. National Identity Card
02. Valid passport
03. Valid Sri Lankan Driving Licence.

Candidates must enter the examination hall without covering their faces to verify their identity, and must not cover their ears to verify that they are not wearing electronic communication devices. Candidates who do not agree to this will not be admitted to the examination hall. Furthermore, they should not cover their faces and ears from the moment they enter the examination hall until they leave after the examination is over.

- (5) Issuing of the Examination Admission Card to a candidate, shall not be considered as fulfillment of the eligibilities for he/she appearing for the examination.
- (6) To appear for the examination, shall submit the Admission Card in which his/her signature has been certified.
- (7) Candidates shall be subject to the rules and regulations laid down by the Commissioner General of Examinations in relation to the conduct of the examination and the release of results. If such rules are violated, they may be subject to the penalties imposed by the Commissioner General of Examinations. Furthermore, the decision of the Commissioner General of Examinations regarding the examination results shall be final.

Rejection of Applications

Your application may be rejected for the following reasons. Therefore, pay serious attention in this regard prior to sending the application.

01. Incomplete or incorrect application.
02. Submission of more than one applications by a candidate.
03. Not forwarding the receipt of correct Payment of Law College Fee to the Law College by email.
04. Failure to submit the originals of the Educational Certificates when required by the Law College.
05. Non fulfillment of Educational Qualifications / other eligibilities at the time of forwarding the application.
06. Having made application on other qualifications apart from the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) or G.C.E. (Advance Level) without the recommendation of the Sri Lanka Law College.

Note

- The money paid for the examination will not be repaid or transferred for another examination for any reason. As well, the Law College Fee paid by you cannot be reclaimed.
- To avoid possible data interruptions during online processes, it is recommended to use a desktop computer when submitting applications and to submit your application before the application deadline.
- **Penalty for false information:** When filling the online Application Form, shall furnish the correct information carefully. As well, when forwarding the application online, the applicant shall agree to the instructions, conditions and rules and regulations given in the Online System. If noncompliance is revealed, at any time before or in the course of or after the examination, his / her candidature may be cancelled.
- If it appears that there exists any discrepancy or inconsistency between the language phrases of this notice published in Sinhala, Tamil and English media, at that instant it would be acted upon the Sinhala Medium Notice.
